9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS  
11 DEVELOPMENT FINANCE AUTHORITY FOR THE BIENNIAL  
12 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2007; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS DEVELOPMENT  
17 FINANCE AUTHORITY APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
18 2005-2007 BIENNIUM.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas  
25 Development Finance Authority for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following  
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
34 or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5)

1 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed  
 2 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its  
 3 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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 5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 6 appropriated, to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable  
 7 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas  
 8 Development Finance Authority, for personal services and operating expenses  
 9 of the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the biennial period ending  
 10 June 30, 2007, the following:

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 28 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY  
 30 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized in the HUD  
 31 Home Program Item (07) of Section 2 of this Act which remains at the close of  
 32 the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2004~~ 2006 shall be carried forward and made  
 33 available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ended June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.  
 34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005  
 35 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

1 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUD HOME  
 3 PROGRAM DISBURSEMENTS. The disbursement of funds appropriated in the HUD Home  
 4 Program Item (07) of Section 2 of this Act shall be in accordance with the  
 5 State of Arkansas Consolidated Plan developed and administered in part by the  
 6 Arkansas Development Finance Authority and shall be in accordance with  
 7 project requirements and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and  
 8 Urban Development HOME Program.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003  
 10 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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 12 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 13 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 14 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 15 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 16 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 17 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 18 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 19 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 20 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 22 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 23 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 24 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
 25 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
 26 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
 27 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
 28 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
 29 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 31 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
 32 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
 33 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
 34 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
 35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
 36 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
2 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.

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
