## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONNEL BY  
THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE STATE MILITARY  
DEPARTMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

CONCERNING THE EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONNEL  
BY THE ADJUTANT GENERAL OF THE STATE  
MILITARY DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-61-107 is amended to read as follows:  
12-61-107. Employment of personnel.

(a) The Adjutant General shall have such assistance and such clerks,  
employees, and laborers as may be necessary from time to time who shall be  
appointed and may be removed by him or her at his discretion.

(b)(1) The Adjutant General may designate those positions that require  
the employee to be a member of the Arkansas National Guard.

(2) This subsection shall only apply to a person who begins  
employment with the Military Department of the State of Arkansas after the  
effective date of this act.
