## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF A STUDENT'S SOCIAL  
10 SECURITY NUMBER AS A STUDENT IDENTIFICATION  
11 NUMBER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

14 THE STUDENT IDENTITY PROTECTION ACT.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
18

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-18-208 is amended to add an additional*  
20 *subsection to read as follows:*

21 *(d)(1) Beginning with the 2005-2006 school year, no school or school*  
22 *district shall:*

23 *(A) Use, display, release, or print a student's social*  
24 *security number or any part of the number on any report, identification card,*  
25 *identification badge, or any document that will be made available or released*  
26 *to the public, a student, or a student's parent or guardian without the*  
27 *express written consent of the student's parent, if the student is a minor,*  
28 *or the student, if the student is eighteen (18) years of age or older; or*

29 *(B) Make a student's social security number available by*  
30 *reading the magnetic strip or other encoded information on the student's*  
31 *identification card.*

32 *(2) This section shall not apply to educational records that are*  
33 *transferred to or between the Department of Education, other public schools*  
34 *or school districts, or other governmental agencies as allowed or required by*  
35 *federal law, state law, or State Board of Education rule.*
