 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the War Memorial Stadium Commission for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred twenty five (125) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the War Memorial Stadium Commission, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the War Memorial Stadium Commission, for personal services and operating expenses of the War Memorial Stadium Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

- 10 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
- 12 BALANCES WAR MEMORIAL STADIUM CASH FUND BALANCE. (A) For all
- 13 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
- 14 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
- 15 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause the War Memorial Stadium
- 16 Cash Fund Balance to decline below two hundred ten thousand seven hundred
- thirty dollars (\$210,730), the disbursing officer shall immediately notify
- 18 the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under
- 19 these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with
- 20 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the
- 21 expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to
- 22 justify the expenditures and shall include the following:
- 23 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 24 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 25 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
- 26 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 27 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 28 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 29 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 30 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 31 depletion of the fund balance.
- 32 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 33 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 34 prior review by the Legislative Council.
- 35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 2005
- 36 through June 30, 2005 2007.

2	SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
3	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
4	made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
5	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
6	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
8	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
9	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
10	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
11	
12	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
13	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
14	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
15	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
16	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
17	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
18	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
19	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
20	
21	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
22	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
23	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
24	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
25	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
26	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
27	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
28	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
29	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
30	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
31	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
