23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
26 State Highway and Transportation Department for the biennial period ending
27 June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007, the following maximum number of regular employees and the
28 maximum annual salary for such employees; and no greater salary than that
29 established herein shall be paid to any employee from appropriations
30 hereinafter made for said department. The annual salaries to be paid to each
31 employee authorized herein shall be determined by the Arkansas Highway
32 Commission within the limitations as set out in this Section and the funds
33 and the appropriations made available for such purposes. All positions
34 established herein shall be exempt from the provisions of the Uniform
35 Personnel Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
36 seq.), or its successor, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of the



1 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act. Provided further that the
 2 salaries for the pay periods beginning June 24, ~~2004~~ 2006 and June 23, ~~2005~~
 3 2007 can be paid from the salaries and overtime authorized for the fiscal
 4 years ending June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007 and June 30, ~~2006~~ 2008 respectively.

30 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME.
 32 The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to pay overtime to its
 33 employees, and the administration thereof shall be in accordance with the
 34 policies established by the Commission. The executives and administrators of
 35 the Department shall be exempt from overtime payments as will certain
 36 professional employees occupying positions specifically exempt under the

1 overtime policies established by the Commission.

2 For the purpose of paying overtime, any portion of Item 2 of Section 2 may

4 INSURANCE PREMIUM REIMBURSEMENT. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby
5 authorized to reimburse from funds appropriated in Item (4) of Section 2 of

7 liability insurance premiums paid by State Highway and Transportation
8 Department employees for liability coverage on state owned vehicles of the
9 Highway and Transportation Department up to a maximum of Fifty Dollars (\$50)

16 UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS. The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation
17 Department is authorized to pay from Item (3) of Section 2 hereof, the
18 Unemployment Premiums and Workers Compensation Premiums, at a rate not in
19 excess of the Agency's experience rate, under the provisions of regulations
20 established by the Department of Finance and Administration.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
22 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

24 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REPORTING
26 REQUIREMENTS. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to take
27 appropriate action as necessary to restrict or reduce the operating,
28 administration, and other associated costs of the State Highway and
29 Transportation Department, including the Arkansas Highway Police Division,
30 for the biennial period ending June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007. Provided further, that
31 the Arkansas Highway Commission is directed to furnish the Arkansas
32 Legislative Council with an expenditure status report regarding the financial
33 activities of the State Highway and Transportation Department at least
34 quarterly, beginning no later than September 30, 1989.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
36 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

2 SECTION 13. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
3 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
4 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
5 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

11
12 SECTION 14. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
13 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
14 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
15 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
16 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
17 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
18 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
19 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

20
21 SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
22 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
23 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
26 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
27 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
28 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
29 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
30 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
