15 AN ACT FOR THE STATE FORESTRY  
16 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
17 2005-2007 BIENNIUM.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
24 Forestry Commission for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number  
25 of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of  
26 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et  
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,  
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein  
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform  
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
33 successor.

13 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State Forestry  
 14 Commission for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-  
 15 time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
 16 appropriated herein for such purposes: ninety (90) temporary or part-time  
 17 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 18 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
 19 for the appropriate classification.

21 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION – ADMINISTRATION PROGRAM. There is hereby  
 22 appropriated, to be payable from the funds and fund accounts as set out  
 23 herein, to the State Forestry Commission for the biennial period ending June  
 24 30, 2007, the following:

25 (a) For the Administration Program, the sum of \$2,671,337 for the 2005-2006  
 26 fiscal year and \$2,697,866 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year.

27 (1) Program Description. AFC administration, which includes personnel,  
 28 fiscal, and conservation education, will lead, direct, and support employees  
 29 to accomplish the agency mission.

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - FOREST RESOURCE PROTECTION AND MANAGEMENT

PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to be payable from the funds and fund accounts as set out herein, to the State Forestry Commission for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

(a) For the Forest Resource Protection/Mgmt Program, the sum of \$20,792,210 for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and \$21,111,507 for the 2006-2007 fiscal year.

(1) Program Description. The AFC is responsible for the protection of Arkansas' forest through wildland fire protection, law enforcement and rural community fire protection, and works with private non-industrial forest landowners, forest industry, university, private forest consultants, other governmental agencies, and communities to promote stewardship and sustainability of Arkansas' rural and urban forests.

19 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA

21 HELP PROVISION. No employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who is

22 employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed 3/4 of the maximum

23 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-

24 201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor may such employee be employed for a

25 period of time to exceed nine (9) months in any single fiscal year.

26 Provided, however, that no employee of the Arkansas Forestry Commission who

27 is employed as "Extra Help" may receive an amount to exceed seventy five

28 percent (75%) of the maximum annual salary for a comparable position as

29 authorized by Arkansas Code 21-5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor

30 shall such employee be employed for a period of time to exceed fourteen

31 hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal year.

32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003

33 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

35 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND

1 BALANCES - STATE FORESTRY TRUST FUND. (A) For all appropriations as provided  
 2 in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund  
 3 balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed  
 4 expenditures would cause the State Forestry Trust Fund to decline below five  
 5 hundred thirty-one thousand twenty two dollars (\$531,022), the disbursing  
 6 officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. Prior to  
 7 any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head shall  
 8 file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State  
 9 requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide  
 10 sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the  
 11 following:

- 12 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 13 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 14 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
- 15 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 16 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 17 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 18 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 19 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 20 depletion of the fund balance.

21 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and  
 22 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought  
 23 prior review by the Legislative Council.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003  
 25 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

26

27 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 28 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 29 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 30 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
2 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
4 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
5 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
6 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
7 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
8 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9  
10 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
11 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
12 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
15 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
16 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
17 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
18 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
19 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
20 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
