Further, the 11 General Assembly has determined that the Department of Education -Educational Television Division may operate more efficiently if some 12 flexibility is provided to the Department of Education - Educational 13 14 Television Division authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, 15 it is both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain 16 oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint 17 Budget Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of 18 19 this section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 20 21 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 23 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 24 25 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Amend Arkansas Code 6-3-110 regarding 26 Appropriation and Annual Audit of State Employees for Arkansas Educational 27 Television Commission to read as follows: 28 29 -(a) No appropriation made available to the Arkansas Educational Television 30 Commission or the Division of Educational Television of the Department of 31 Education shall be available until such time as the chairman of the 32 commission certifies, in writing, to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee 33 that an audit is being conducted of the Arkansas Educational 34 Telecommunications Network Foundation for the previous fiscal year and has 35 promptly been made available to that committee. (b) At the end of each fiscal year, the chairman of the commission shall 36

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1 initiate an audit of the foundation by a recognized and certified public

2 accounting firm acceptable to the Legislative Auditor with such audit

3 standards and schedules that may be promulgated by the Legislative Auditor,

4 such audit to be paid for by the foundation.

5 (e) (a) No person employed by the commission and paid from state funds shall 6 receive supplemental compensation or remuneration from funds not appropriated 7 by the state.

8 (d) (b) In fulfilling their day-to-day responsibilities, state employees of 9 the division are to be supervised only by appropriate state employees. A "state employee" is defined as one paid by funds appropriated by the General 10 11 Assembly. No person or employee paid with funds not appropriated by the 12 General Assembly shall supervise any state employee of the division. No person employed by the commission and paid from state funds shall receive 13 14 supplemental compensation or remuneration from funds not appropriated by the 15 state.

SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 18 19 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 20 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 21 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 22 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 23 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 25 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

27 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 32 33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 34 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 35

36 <u>SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General

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1	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
2	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
7	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
9	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
10	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
