(iv) Copies may be furnished without charge or at a reduced charge if the custodian determines that the records have been requested primarily for noncommercial purposes and that waiver or reduction of the fee is in the public interest. (B) The custodian shall provide an itemized breakdown of charges under subdivision (d)(3)(A) of this section.
