14 AN ACT TO GIVE CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT
15 OFFICERS FROM ADJOINING STATES THE
16 ABILITY TO DISCHARGE OFFICIAL DUTIES IN
17 ARKANSAS UNDER SPECIFIC CIRCUMSTANCES.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 81, Subchapter 1 is amended
24 to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 16-81-115. Certified law enforcement officers from adjoining states.

26 (a) A certified law enforcement officer from an adjoining state who is
27 in Arkansas shall have the authorization to act as described in subsection
28 (b) of this section, if the officer is:

29 (1) Regularly assigned to duty in a municipality that is within
30 one (1) mile of an Arkansas border;

31 (2) On duty in his or her regularly assigned municipality at the
32 time he or she enters the city limits of the Arkansas municipality; and

33 (3) Within the city limits of the Arkansas municipality that
34 adjoins the municipality to which the officer is regularly assigned.

35 (b) A certified law enforcement officer who meets the requirements of
36 subsection (a) of this section:



1 (1) Has the same powers, duties, and immunities as a certified
2 law enforcement officer of Arkansas who is acting in the discharge of an
3 official duty; and

4 (2) May enforce the ordinances of an Arkansas municipality if
5 the governing body of the municipality authorizes that enforcement.

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7 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
8 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is currently no statute
9 that authorizes certified law enforcement officers from border cities to
10 assist Arkansas law enforcement officers, and a statute is needed for the
11 more efficient enforcement of Arkansas law. Therefore, an emergency is
12 declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
13 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
14 on:

15 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

16 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
17 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
18 bill; or

19 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
20 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.

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
