AN ACT TO AMEND THE VALUED POLICY LAW TO ADDRESS
CLAIMS UNDER TWO (2) OR MORE INSURANCE POLICIES;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND THE VALUED POLICY LAW TO ADDRESS CLAIMS UNDER TWO (2) OR MORE INSURANCE POLICIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 23-88-101 is amended to read as follows: 23-88-101. Valued policy law.
(a) In Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section, in case of a total loss by fire or natural disaster of the property insured, a property insurance policy other than for flood and earthquake insurance shall be held and considered to be a liquidated demand against the company taking the risk for the full amount stated in the policy or the full amount upon which the company charges, collects, or receives a premium.
(b) (1) If the property is insured by two (2) or more insurers, then the insured's total recovery from all insurance coverage shall not exceed the amount recoverable under the policy with the highest stated value.
(2) The terms of the policies shall dictate the percentage to be paid under each policy.
(b) (c) However, the The provisions of subsections (a) and (b) of this section shall not apply to:
(1) personal Personal property or detached or appurtenant


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    structures; or
