## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REPEAL OUTDATED LANGUAGE REGARDING  
MINIMUM WAGES PAID TO EMPLOYEES OF THE ARKANSAS  
FORESTRY COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO REPEAL OUTDATED LANGUAGE  
REGARDING MINIMUM WAGES PAID TO  
EMPLOYEES OF THE ARKANSAS FORESTRY  
COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-31-105(c), requiring a minimum wage of one dollar (\$1.00) per hour for Arkansas Forestry Commission employees, is repealed:

~~(c)(1) The commission shall pay employees employed on an hourly wage basis a minimum wage of at least one dollar (\$1.00) per hour for each hour worked.~~

~~(2) Failure or refusal of the commission to pay the minimum wage provided herein shall be malfeasance in office and punishable accordingly.~~
