BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 16, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-16-137. Organized sports credit.
(a) Beginning in the 2005-2006 school year, students in grades nine through twelve (9-12) who are members of the Arkansas National Guard or Reserves during the summer immediately preceding their senior year and who successfully complete basic training shall be awarded:
(1) One (1) unit of physical education credit; and
(2) One (1) unit of health and safety education.
(b) A student qualifying for credit under subsection (a) of this section who successfully maintains membership in the Arkansas National Guard or Reserves shall be awarded one (1) unit oral communications credit or one (1) unit fine arts credit for each semester of his or her senior year during which he or she successfully maintains membership in the Arkansas National Guard or Reserves.
(c) A student entitled to an award under this section shall provide


written documentation verifying:
(1) Completion of basic training; and
(2) Membership in the Arkansas National Guard or Reserves. (d) The State Board of Education shall promulgate rules to implement this section.
