AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ARKANSAS FIRE AND POLICE
PENSION REVIEW BOARD TO MEET IN EXECUTIVE SESSION
WITH THE ARKANSAS LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE
RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD; TO ALLOW RECORDS
CONCERNING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR THAT ARE
CREATED BY THE BOARD TO BE CONSIDERED PERSONNEL
RECORDS OR JOB EVALUATION OR PERFORMANCE RECORDS;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE FIRE AND POLICE
PENSION REVIEW BOARD TO MEET IN
EXECUTIVE SESSION WITH THE LOCAL POLICE
AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM BOARD; TO
ALLOW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR RECORDS CREATED
BY THE BOARD TO BE PERSONNEL RECORDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-203(h), concerning the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board, is amended as follows:

(h)(1) The executive director and staff of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System shall serve as executive director and staff for the board.

(2)(A) The Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board or its designated members may meet in executive session with the Arkansas Local



Police and Fire Retirement System Board or its designated members for the purposes stated in and subject to the provisions of § 25-19-106(c) concerning the boards' executive director, staff, or persons being considered for any of those positions.

(B)(i) When applicable, records created by or at the instruction of the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board concerning the boards' executive director or staff shall be considered personnel records, or job evaluation or performance records for purposes of and subject to the provisions of §§ 25-19-105(b)(12) and 25-19-105(c).

(ii) The records in subdivision (h)(2)(B)(i) of this section may be made available to the Arkansas Fire and Police Pension Review Board or its designated members and the Boards' executive director.
