2	policies for classified personnel which consists of at least one (1)		
3	nonmanagement representative from each of the following five (5)		
4	classifications:

8	(D) Secretarial and clerical; and		
9	(E) Aides and paraprofessionals.		
10	(2) Any classification of support personnel not identified in

12	(b) There shall be no more than three (3) administrators on the
