19	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-10-1704, concerning the assisted living		
20	program, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:		
21	(j) Residential care facilities that choose to offer assisted living		
22	services are not exempted from assisted living licensure except as provided		
23	in this subchapter.		
24			
25	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-10-1709 repealed:		
26	(a) Facilities offering assisted living services must obtain a permit		
27	of approval. Provided, however, that permits of approval held by residential		
28	care facilities as of April 2, 2001, or held by subsequent purchasers of		
29	those facilities, shall also be considered permits of approval for assisted		
30	living without further action. However, residential care facilities that		
31	choose to offer assisted living services are not exempted from assisted		
32	living licensure requirements except as provided in § 20-10-1704.		
33	(b)(1)(A) Provided, further, that in order to take advantage of a		
34	Robert Wood Johnson Foundation grant, one (1) new facility chosen by the		
35	Department of Human Services may serve as a pilot project without the		
26	possessity of a permit of approval. This facility shall be exempt from the		

1	permit of approval process provided that in 2001 it is awarded funding from	
2	the Coming Home Project and tax credits from the Arkansas Development Financ	
3	Authority.	
4	(B) The Coming Home Project means the Robert Wood Johnson
