## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE LICENSE PLATES TO INCLUDE A DESIGNATION OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS REGISTERED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REQUIRE LICENSE PLATES TO INCLUDE A DESIGNATION OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE MOTOR VEHICLE IS REGISTERED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-14-715 is amended to read as follows:
27-14-715. Issuance of license plates.
(a) The office, upon registering a vehicle, shall issue to the owner one (1) license plate for a motorcycle, trailer, or semitrailer and one (l) or two (2) license plates for every other motor vehicle.
(b)(1) Every license plate shall have displayed upon it the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued, also the name of this state, which may be abbreviated, and the year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration thereof.
(2) Beginning on January 1, 2006, every license plate issued shall include a designation of the county in which the motor vehicle is registered.
(c)(1) The Except as provided in subdivision (c) (2) of this section, the license plates and required letters and numerals thereon, except the year number for which issued, shall be of sufficient size to be plainly readable from a distance of one hundred feet (100') during daylight.
(2) The requirements of subdivision (c) (1) of this section shall not apply to the year number for which the license plate is issued or the county designation.
(d) The office shall issue for every passenger motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type of license plates as the type of plates issued for a private passenger vehicle.
