23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
26 Department of Human Services - Division of County Operations for the 2005-  
27 2007 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose  
28 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification  
29 and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor,  
30 and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to  
31 which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be  
32 exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation  
33 Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed  
34 by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act  
35 (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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 5 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of  
 6 Human Services - Division of County Operations for the 2005-2007 biennium,  
 7 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known  
 8 as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes:  
 9 thirty-seven (37) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of  
 10 pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
 11 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
 12 classification.

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 14 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - COMMODITY DISTRIBUTION AND SALVAGE CONTAINER -

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8 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY  
 10 OPERATIONS - CARRY FORWARD. The unexpended balances in appropriations made  
 11 from federal funds, for County Operations, as provided for in this Act on  
 12 June 30, ~~2004~~ 2006 shall be carried forward and made available for  
 13 expenditures for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2005~~  
 14 2007.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005  
 16 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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18 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
 20 OF TANF BLOCK GRANT FUNDS TO THE CHILD CARE DEVELOPMENT FUND. Not  
 21 withstanding any federal regulations or mandates for the biennium that  
 22 prohibits the use of funds for this purpose, the Department of Human  
 23 Services, Division of County Operations shall transfer a total of \$12 million  
 24 or 11 percent; whichever amount is less, of the state's federal Temporary  
 25 Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) block grant to the Child Care Development  
 26 Fund. The funds, to be administered by the Division of Child Care and Early  
 27 Childhood Education, shall be used to provide subsidized child care for TEA,  
 28 transitional child care, or other low-income families. These funds shall be  
 29 used to develop, support, enhance and subsidize early care and education  
 30 programs.

31 The amount of transfer is subject to continuation of base level funding for  
 32 the Division of County Operations.

33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005  
 34 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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36 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
3 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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10 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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19 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
24 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
25 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
26 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
27 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
28 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
