20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-16-106 is amended to read as follows:

23 14-16-106. Sale or disposal of surplus property.

24 (a) If it is determined by the county judge to be surplus, any  
25 personal or real property owned by a county may be sold at public auction to  
26 the highest bidder.

27 (b)(1) Notice of the public auction shall be published at least once a  
28 week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation  
29 in the county.

30 (2) The notice shall specify the description of the property to  
31 be sold and the time and place of the public auction.

32 (c) If it is determined by the county judge and county assessor that  
33 any personal property owned by a county is junk, scrap, discarded, or  
34 otherwise of no value to the county, then the property may be disposed of in  
35 any manner deemed appropriate by the county judge. However, the county judge  
36 shall report monthly to the quorum court any property that has been disposed
