## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE COUNTY JUDGES TO DISPOSE OF DISCARDED SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-16-106 is amended to read as follows:
14-16-106. Sale or disposal of surplus property.
(a) If it is determined by the county judge to be surplus, any personal or real property owned by a county may be sold at public auction to the highest bidder.
(b)(1) Notice of the public auction shall be published at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper having general circulation in the county.
(2) The notice shall specify the description of the property to be sold and the time and place of the public auction.
(c) If it is determined by the county judge and county assessor that any personal property owned by a county is junk, scrap, discarded, or otherwise of no value to the county, then the property may be disposed of in any manner deemed appropriate by the county judge. However, the county judge shall report monthly to the quorum court any property that has been disposed
of under this subsection (c).
