1 2 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 3 PROFESSIONAL FEES AND SERVICES RESTRICTION. Of the funds appropriated for 4 5 Professional Fees and Services, \$150,000 is restricted in each of the two 6 fiscal years for securing professional services, in areas of expertise other 7 than audit, for any special needs or requirements associated with any program 8 evaluations and/or special reports. Any unexpended balance of appropriations 9 which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 2006 shall 10 be transferred forward and made available for the year ending June 30, 2005 11 2007. Services contracted pursuant to this provision shall only be secured 12 upon approval of the Executive Committee of the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 13 14 1, 2003 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 15 16 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. Any unexpended balance of the appropriations of Regular Salaries, 18 19 Personal Services Matching or Maintenance and General Operations in Section 2 of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 20 21 2004 2006 shall be transferred forward and made available for the same 22 purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005 2007. The provisions of 23 this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 2005 through June 30, 24 2005 2007. 25 26 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 28 PROVISION - LINE ITEMS. The Legislative Auditor is hereby authorized to 29 direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to transfer appropriation 30 between the line items of the appropriation in Section 2 of this Act in such amounts determined necessary in either fiscal year of the 2003-2005 2005-2007 31 32 biennium. In no event, however, shall the Regular Salaries line item in 33 Section 2 be increased or decreased by such transfers authorized herein, 34 until the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee reviews such transfers. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 35

1, 2003 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

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2 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 3 4 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation and funding authorized 5 for the audit of the State of Arkansas' Comprehensive Annual Financial Report 6 (CAFR) in Section 3 of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year 7 ending June 30, 2004 2006 shall be carried forward and made available for the 8 same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005 2007. The provisions 9 of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 2005 through June 10 30, 2005 2007. SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

13 SUPPLEMENT CAFR APPROPRIATION. Because the audit of the State's financial 14 15 statements is essential to provide adequate information to the General 16 Assembly to determine the needs and legislative requirements of the state, to 17 provide adequate information to the Governor for proper management of the 18 affairs of the State, and to issue bonds from time to time, the payment of 19 the cost for securing the services of an independent auditor to audit the State of Arkansas' Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR AUDIT) 20 21 appropriation authorized in Section 3 herein may be supplemented through the 22 transfer of any other appropriations and funds available to the Division of 23 Legislative Audit in the event that the appropriation or funding provided for 24 the audit of the CAFR is inadequate. The provisions of this section shall be 25 in effect only from July 1, 2003 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

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SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1	SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
2	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
3	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
4	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
5	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
6	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
7	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
8	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
9	
10	SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
11	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
12	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
13	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
14	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
15	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
16	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
17	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
18	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
19	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
20	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
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
