19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-13-310 is amended to read as follows:
22 5-13-310. Terroristic act.

23 (a) For the purposes of this section, a person commits a terroristic
24 act when, while not in the commission of a lawful act:

25 (1) He or she shoots at or in any manner projects an object,
26 with the purpose to cause injury to another person or other persons or damage
27 to property, at a conveyance which is being operated or which is occupied by
28 passengers another person or other persons; or

29 (2) He or she shoots, with the purpose to cause injury to a
30 person or persons or damage to property, at an occupiable structure.

31 (b)(1) Any person who shall commit a terroristic act as defined in
32 subsection (a) of this section shall be deemed guilty of a Class B felony.

33 (2) Any person who shall commit a terroristic act as defined in
34 subsection (a) of this section shall be deemed guilty of a Class Y felony if
35 the person, with the purpose of causing physical injury to another person,
36 causes serious physical injury or death to any person.



1 (c) This section shall not repeal any laws or parts of laws in
2 conflict herewith, but shall be supplemental thereto.
