20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 9, Chapter 13, Subchapter 1 is amended*
23 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

24 9-13-108. Drug testing – Proceedings concerning child custody,
25 visitation, or the welfare of a child.

26 (a) For purposes of this section, “drug” means any controlled
27 substance as defined by the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, § 5-64-101 et
28 seq.

29 (b) In a proceeding concerning child custody, child visitation, or the
30 welfare of a child, the court may order drug testing of a party upon
31 application of a party or by its own motion.

32 (c) The court may assess the cost of the drug testing to a party or
33 parties or otherwise order or arrange payment of the cost of drug testing.
