20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-30-205 is amended to read as follows:

23 12-30-205. Purchase of goods by nonprofit organizations and other
24 individuals.

25 (a) Nonprofit organizations may ~~also~~ purchase goods produced by the
26 Department of Correction utilizing prison labor as provided for by this
27 subchapter upon the condition that the goods may not be resold for profit.

28 (b)(1) Goods produced by the department utilizing prison labor as
29 provided for by this subchapter may also be purchased by: ~~current employees~~
30 ~~and retirees of the department~~

31 (A) Current employees and retirees of the Department
32 of Correction;

33 (B) All employees of the offices, departments,
34 institutions, and agencies of this state which are supported in whole or in
35 part by this state and political subdivisions of this state;

36 (C) All employees of nonprofit organizations which



1 purchase goods produced by the Department of Correction utilizing prison
2 labor under subsection (a) of this section;

3 (D) Current and former members of the Board of
4 Corrections; and ~~for personal use only and not for resale~~

5 (E) Members of the General Assembly.

6 (2) Goods purchased by individuals under subdivision (b)(1) of
7 this section shall be for personal use only and not for resale.
