All other donation instruments shall contain provisions by which the title to the property donated shall revert to the municipal corporation when the donated property is no longer used by the donee for the purposes for which it was donated. (c) The execution of all contracts and conveyances and lease contracts shall be performed by the mayor and city clerk or recorder, when authorized by a resolution, in writing, approved by a majority vote of the city council present and participating. /s/ Overbey, et al
