## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS;
TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN PUBLIC; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS AND TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN PUBLIC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5 is amended to add an additional chapter to read as follows:

5-80-101. Definitions.
As used in this act:
(1) "Public place" means a publicly or privately owned place to which the public or substantial numbers of people have access; and
(2) "Sell" means the actual, constructive, or attempted transfer from one (1) person to another of a product or products in exchange for money or anything of value, whether or not there is an agency relationship.

5-80-102. Smoking in public - Prohibited.
(a) A person shall not smoke a cigarette, cigar, pipe, or use any other tobacco product in a public place.
(b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) and not more than one thousand dollars $(\$ 1,000)$. 5-80-103. Sale of tobacco products - Prohibited. (a) A person shall not sell any cigarette, cigar, pipe, or other tobacco product or any combination thereof to any person within the State of Arkansas.
(b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100) and not more than one thousand dollars $(\$ 1,000)$.
