19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-19-501 is amended to read as follows:
22 27-19-501. Report required.

23 The driver of a vehicle of a type subject to registration under the
24 motor vehicle laws of this state that is in any manner involved in an
25 accident within this state, which accident has resulted in damage to the
26 property of any one (1) person in excess of ~~five hundred dollars (\$500)~~ one
27 thousand dollars (\$1,000) or in bodily injury to or in the death of any
28 person shall report the accident within thirty (30) days after the accident
29 on an electronic or paper form approved by the Director of the Department of
30 Finance and Administration to the Office of Driver Services subject to the
31 exemptions provided in §§ 27-19-509 and 27-19-604.
