AN ACT TO INCREASE THE DAMAGE LIMIT FOR REPORTING
ACCIDENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
ADMINISTRATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO INCREASE THE DAMAGE LIMIT FOR
REPORTING ACCIDENTS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF
FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-19-501 is amended to read as follows:
27-19-501. Report required.

The driver of a vehicle of a type subject to registration under the motor vehicle laws of this state that is in any manner involved in an accident within this state, which accident has resulted in damage to the property of any one (1) person in excess of ~~five hundred dollars (\$500)~~ one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or in bodily injury to or in the death of any person shall report the accident within thirty (30) days after the accident on an electronic or paper form approved by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration to the Office of Driver Services subject to the exemptions provided in §§ 27-19-509 and 27-19-604.
