13 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A TEACHER-MENTOR
14 PROGRAM.
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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1 is amended
20 to add an additional section to read as follows:

21 6-17-118. Program to provide a volunteer teacher as a mentor.

22 (a) The State Board of Education shall develop a statewide program for
23 teachers to voluntarily act as mentors to counsel students in grades nine
24 through twelve (9-12) of the public schools of this state in order to help
25 students set after-graduation goals and develop a personal plan to assist in
26 their achievement of those goals.

27 (b) To the extent reasonably practicable, the program shall provide
28 for:

29 (1) The student to have regular, one-on-one counseling with a
30 teacher about curriculum-related concerns, including graduation requirements,
31 course selection, grades, career interests, and college;

32 (2) Annual meetings with the student and his or her parents or
33 guardian to review the student's progress and select courses for the next
34 year;

35 (3) Ongoing communication with the parents or guardian about the
36 student's progress; and



1 (4) Other appropriate activities that will support the student's
2 efforts to achieve his or her after-graduation goals.

3 (c) By August 1, 2005, the board shall promulgate rules to implement
4 this section.

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
