## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A TEACHER-MENTOR PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 1 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-17-118. Program to provide a volunteer teacher as a mentor.
(a) The State Board of Education shall develop a statewide program for teachers to voluntarily act as mentors to counsel students in grades nine through twelve (9-12) of the public schools of this state in order to help students set after-graduation goals and develop a personal plan to assist in their achievement of those goals.
(b) To the extent reasonably practicable, the program shall provide for:
(1) The student to have regular, one-on-one counseling with a teacher about curriculum-related concerns, including graduation requirements, course selection, grades, career interests, and college;
(2) Annual meetings with the student and his or her parents or guardian to review the student's progress and select courses for the next year;
(3) Ongoing communication with the parents or guardian about the student's progress; and
