PROVISION. Upon approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the

- 25 ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee drawing a salary or
- 26 other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind
- 27 shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other
- 28 than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other
- 29 agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's

- 32 interfere with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary
- 33 duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not
- 34 exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the

The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the State Treasurer are 12 authorized to establish a joint paying account in the State Treasury, upon direction of the Board of Trustees for the Arkansas School for the Blind and 13 14 the Arkansas School for the Deaf. 3	SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
4	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
5	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
9	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
10	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
11	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
12	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
13	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
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
