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SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the 30 31 Arkansas School for the Blind shall transfer appropriation from Item No.(08) 32 Summer Projects, in Section 3 of this Act, to Item No. (01) through Item No. 33 (05) in Section 3 of this Act, to compensate Teachers, Houseparents, Food 34 Service, Nursing staff who work during the summer months on summer projects, 35 and to cover other expenses of summer project activities and to compensate 36 coaches and organization sponsors as referenced in Section 9 of this Act.

36 <u>SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General

3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
7	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
8	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
