The Department of Arkansas 16 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer 17 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee 18 19 health insurance plan. 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BALANCES - STATE POLICE EQUIPMENT FUND. (A) For all appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause the State Police Equipment Fund to decline

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- l below one million three hundred eighty eight thousand eight hundred thirty
- 2 five dollars (\$1,388,835), the disbursing officer shall immediately notify
- 3 the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under
- 4 these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with
- 5 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the
- 6 expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to
- 7 justify the expenditures and shall include the following:

- 25 RATES OF PAY. Due to the necessity of maintaining public safety and the
- 26 highly competitive job market conditions for law enforcement personnel, the
- 27 Arkansas State Police is authorized special rates of pay for current and new
- 28 employees up to the levels listed below:
- 29 T039 State Police Trooper Grade 19 \$34,405
- 30 Pay Level IIM
- 31 T054 Trooper Ist Class Grade 20 \$36,644
- 32 Pay Level IIM
- 33 Commissioned employees who are hired as State Police Troopers will be
- 34 considered Recruits within the grade 19 classification and shall remain at
- 35 Pay Level I until the successful completion of recruit school. These
- 36 employees will then be considered Trainees for the next 12 months of

- 1 employment and shall be eligible for a salary adjustment not to exceed a rate
- 2 that is equal to fifty percent (50%) of the range between Pay Level 1 and Pay
- 3 Level II of grade 19. After satisfactory completion of 12 months of
- 4 employment as a Trainee, the Trainee will become eligible for promotion to
- 5 State Police Trooper and shall be eligible for salary adjustments up to Pay
- 6 Level II of the grade 19. be eligible for additional compensation at the
- 7 successful completion of six months of service. These employees will then be
- 8 considered trainees for the next 12 months and at the end of 18 months of
- 9 total service shall be eligible for a salary adjustment not to exceed Pay
- 10 Level IIM.

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- 11 Current commissioned uniform employees whose salaries were awarded a one
- 12 time adjustment by Act 1609 of 2003 and whose salaries exceed Pay Level IV,
- 13 <u>shall not be considered as exceeding the line item maximum of the employee's</u>
- 14 <u>assigned grade</u>.
- 15 After completion of four and a half years of employment the Commissioned
- 16 employee will be eligible for promotion to Trooper First Class, grade 20.
- 17 After seven and a half years of employment, the employee will be eligible for
- 18 promotion to Corporal, grade 21. Employees will be eligible for normal
- 19 promotion increases as they advance to the classifications of Sergeant,
- 20 Lieutenant, Captain, and Major. Any disciplinary actions taken against an
- 21 employee may delay the promotional process.
- 22 Current employees shall be eligible for equity adjustments of up to 3% as
- 23 deemed necessary by the Arkansas State Police. Applications for these
- 24 special rates of pay indicated above shall have been reviewed and approved by
- 25 the Office of Personnel Management after prior review by the Arkansas
- 26 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

28 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

- 29 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 30 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 31 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

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2	SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
3	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
4	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
5	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
6	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
7	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
8	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
9	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
10	
11	SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
12	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
13	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
14	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
15	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
16	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
17	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
18	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
19	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
20	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
21	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
