## Subtitle

17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS  
18 STATE POLICE APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
19 2005-2007 BIENNIUM.

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
25 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following  
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
34 or its successor.

SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COURT AWARDS FUND – MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. Monies deposited in the Court Awards Fund each fiscal year shall be used exclusively for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor vehicle renovation costs for the Department of Arkansas State Police.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR VEHICLE ACQUISITION REVOLVING FUND - MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASES/RENOVATION. At least fifty percent (50%) of the general revenues deposited each fiscal year into the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be used for motor vehicle purchases and or motor vehicle renovation costs for the Department of Arkansas State Police.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized, after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior

1 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to  
2 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds  
3 Transfer" to the Capital Outlay line item contained in the operations  
4 appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and shall be used  
5 exclusively for motor vehicle purchases and associated taxes and/or motor  
6 vehicle renovation costs for the Department of Arkansas State Police; and to  
7 request fund transfers from the Court Awards Fund to the Department of  
8 Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as  
9 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section.  
10 Further provided, the Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
11 authorized to request a fund transfer from the Court Awards Fund or the  
12 Arkansas State Police Fund to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund.  
13 Fund transfers to the Motor Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be  
14 reported to the Arkansas Legislative Council, but do not require prior

6 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for  
7 *Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations* appropriation in this Act.  
8 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles  
9 used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the  
10 maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~  
12 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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14 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM  
16 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas  
17 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer  
18 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
19 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee  
20 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the  
21 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims  
22 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined  
23 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance  
24 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the  
25 department, the ~~84<sup>th</sup>~~ 85<sup>th</sup> General Assembly shall study the feasibility and  
26 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide  
27 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public  
28 employees insurance program.

32 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
34 BALANCES - STATE POLICE EQUIPMENT FUND. (A) For all appropriations as  
35 provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level  
36 of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any

1 proposed expenditures would cause the State Police Equipment Fund to decline  
2 below one million three hundred eighty eight thousand eight hundred thirty  
3 five dollars (\$1,388,835), the disbursing officer shall immediately notify  
4 the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under  
5 these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with  
6 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the  
7 expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to  
8 justify the expenditures and shall include the following:

- 9 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 10 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 11 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
- 12 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 13 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 14 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 15 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 16 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
- 17 depletion of the fund balance.

18 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and  
19 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought  
20 prior review by the Legislative Council.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003

24 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL  
26 RATES OF PAY. Due to the necessity of maintaining public safety and the  
27 highly competitive job market conditions for law enforcement personnel, the  
28 Arkansas State Police is authorized special rates of pay for current and new  
29 employees up to the levels listed below:

34 Commissioned employees who are hired as State Police Troopers will be  
35 considered Recruits within the grade 19 classification and shall ~~remain at~~  
36 ~~Pay Level I until the successful completion of recruit school. These~~

1 ~~employees will then be considered Trainees for the next 12 months of~~  
2 ~~employment and shall be eligible for a salary adjustment not to exceed a rate~~  
3 ~~that is equal to fifty percent (50%) of the range between Pay Level I and Pay~~  
4 ~~Level II of grade 19. After satisfactory completion of 12 months of~~  
5 ~~employment as a Trainee, the Trainee will become eligible for promotion to~~  
6 ~~State Police Trooper and shall be eligible for salary adjustments up to Pay~~  
7 ~~Level II of the grade 19.~~ be eligible for additional compensation at the  
8 successful completion of six months of service. These employees will then be  
9 considered trainees for the next 12 months and at the end of 18 months of  
10 total service shall be eligible for a salary adjustment not to exceed Pay  
11 Level IIM.

12 Current commissioned uniform employees whose salaries were awarded a one  
13 time adjustment by Act 1609 of 2003 and whose salaries exceed Pay Level IV,  
14 shall not be considered as exceeding the line item maximum of the employee's  
15 assigned grade.

16 After completion of four and a half years of employment the Commissioned  
17 employee will be eligible for promotion to Trooper First Class, grade 20.  
18 After seven and a half years of employment, the employee will be eligible for  
19 promotion to Corporal, grade 21. Employees will be eligible for normal  
20 promotion increases as they advance to the classifications of Sergeant,  
21 Lieutenant, Captain, and Major. Any disciplinary actions taken against an  
22 employee may delay the promotional process.

23 ~~Current employees shall be eligible for equity adjustments of up to 3% as~~  
24 ~~deemed necessary by the Arkansas State Police. Applications for these~~  
25 ~~special rates of pay indicated above shall have been reviewed and approved by~~  
26 ~~the Office of Personnel Management after prior review by the Arkansas~~  
27 ~~Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.~~

29 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
30 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
31 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
32 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
35 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
36 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

1 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

2  
3 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
4 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
5 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
6 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
7 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
8 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
9 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
10 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

11  
12 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
13 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
14 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
15 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
17 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
19 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
20 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
21 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
22 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
