12 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR VEHICLE PURCHASE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby 14 15 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for 16 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act. 17 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles used for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the 18 maximum number of authorized passenger vehicles. 19

The Department of Arkansas 26 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer 27 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 28 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee 29 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the 30 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined 31 32 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance 33 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the department, the 84th 85th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and 34 35 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide 36 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public

1 employees insurance program.

(A) For all appropriations as 8 provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level 9 of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause the State Police Equipment Fund to decline 10 11 below one million three hundred eighty eight thousand eight hundred thirty 12 five dollars (\$1,388,835), the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under 13 14 these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with 15 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the 16 expenditures. 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2 SECTION 22. APPROPRIATION ARKANSAS STATE POLICE - CASH. There is hereby 3 appropriated, to the Arkansas State Police, to be payable from the cash fund 4 deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of 5 the State, for construction of an airport hanger for the biennial period 6 ending June 30, 2007, the sum of\$200,000.

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8 SECTION 23. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 24. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 25. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 29 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 32 33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 36
