10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE BLACK

12 ENDING JUNE 30, 2007; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE BLACK RIVER TECHNICAL  
16 COLLEGE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2005-2007  
17 BIENNIUM.  
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for  
24 the Black River Technical College for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following  
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
33 or its successor.

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36 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the

1 Black River Technical College for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following  
 2 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
 3 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: fifty-two  
 4 (52) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to  
 5 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or  
 6 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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8 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,  
 9 to the Black River Technical College, to be payable from the Black River  
 10 Technical College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
 11 Black River Technical College for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007,

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16       SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - CONTINGENCY. There is hereby appropriated, to  
 17 the Black River Technical College, to be payable from the Black River  
 18 Technical College Fund, for personal services and operating expenses which  
 19 may be transferred and added to any appropriation line item payable from the  
 20 Black River Technical College Fund by the Black River Technical College for  
 21 the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

28       SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
 30 PRIORITIES. A high priority of the Black River Technical College shall be to  
 31 combat illiteracy and to provide industrial training in the work place.

32       The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~  
 33 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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 35       SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND

1 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged  
2 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the  
3 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief  
4 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December  
5 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or  
6 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during  
7 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.  
8 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the  
9 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon  
10 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal  
11 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board  
12 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~  
14 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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16 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
17 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
18 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
19 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures  
22 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this  
23 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
24 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
25 with in disbursement of said funds.

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27 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
28 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
29 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
30 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
31 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
33 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
34 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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36 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

1 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
2 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
3 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
4 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
5 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
6 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
7 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
8 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
9 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
10 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
