36 SECTION 33. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CAFR
- 2 APPROPRIATION. Because the audit of the State's financial statements is
- 3 essential to provide adequate information to the General Assembly to
- 4 determine the needs and legislative requirements of the state, to provide
- adequate information to the Governor for proper management of the affairs of 5
- 6 the State, and to issue bonds from time to time, the payment of the cost for
- 7 securing the services of an independent auditor to audit the State of
- 8 Arkansas' Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR AUDIT) appropriation
- 9 authorized in this Act may be supplemented through the transfer of any other
- 10 appropriations and funds available to the DFA-Management Services in the
- 11 event that the appropriation or funding provided for the audit of the CAFR is
- 12 inadequate.

- 16 SECTION 34. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

- Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 20

- 35 SECTION 36. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 36

3	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
