17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-10-705 is amended to read as follows:

20 (a) The Office of Long-Term Care shall promulgate regulations  
21 necessary to implement an aide training program for all long-term care  
22 facilities in this state, to prescribe in-service training programs, and to  
23 enforce compliance with those programs.

24 (b)(1) The regulations shall require training programs to:

25 (A) Provide no less than ninety (90) clock hours of  
26 training; and

27 (B) Include in those ninety (90) hours no less than  
28 fifteen (15) clock hours of training specific to Alzheimer's and related  
29 dementia.

30 (2) The training programs required under this subsection (b)  
31 shall take effect only if funds are available.
