18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-10-705 is amended to read as follows:

21 (a) The Office of Long-Term Care shall promulgate regulations
22 necessary to implement an aide training program for all long-term care
23 facilities in this state, to prescribe in-service training programs, and to
24 enforce compliance with those programs.

25 (b)(1) The regulations shall require training programs to:

26 (A) Provide no less than ninety (90) clock hours of
27 training; and

28 (B) Include in those ninety (90) hours no less than
29 fifteen (15) clock hours of training specific to Alzheimer's and related
30 dementia.

31 (2) The training programs required under this subsection (b)
32 shall take effect only if funds are available.

33 (3) The training program established under this section shall be
34 known as the "Barbara Broyles Training Program".
