The Departments of Correction and Community 7 Correction, shall at a minimum and on a fiscal year basis, prepare and post 8 on the applicable agency web site, a monthly summary of county jail 9 reimbursement invoices prepared and forwarded to each county sheriff for verification by the Departments and for payment from the County Jail 10 11 Reimbursement Fund. In addition, the report shall include a summary of invoices returned by each county for payment for previous months within the 12 fiscal year, the amounts paid, and any balances owed. Each fiscal year-end 13 report shall be maintained on the web sites for a period of no less than 14 15 three (3) years. 16 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

3	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
4	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
5	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
6	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
