Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

AN ACT TO ALLOW A TEACHER TO EARN UP TO TWELVE (12) HOURS OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CREDIT FOR TIME REQUIRED AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR TO PLAN AND PREPARE A CURRICULUM AND OTHER INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIAL FOR HIS OR HER ASSIGNED CLASSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO ALLOW A TEACHER TO EARN PROFESSIONAL
DEVELOPMENT CREDIT FOR TIME REQUIRED AT
THE BEGINNING OF THE SCHOOL YEAR TO PLAN
AND PREPARE A CURRICULUM AND OTHER

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 17, Subchapter 7 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-17-705. Professional development credit.
(a) Up to twelve (12) hours of professional development credit may be earned by certified personnel for time required at the beginning of each school year to plan and prepare a curriculum and other instructional material for his or her assigned classes, if the time is:
(1) Spent in his or her classroom, office, or media center at the public school; and
(2) Prior to the first day of the school year.
(b) Certified personnel shall earn one (1) hour of professional development credit for each hour of planning and preparation that meets the requirements of subsection (a) of this section.
