21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-51-1407 is repealed.

23 ~~(a) Whenever it shall appear that any horse ridden or driven by any~~
24 ~~person upon any streets, roads, and highways is about to become frightened by~~
25 ~~the approach of any motor vehicle, it shall be the duty of the person driving~~
26 ~~or conducting the motor vehicle to cause it to come to a full stop until the~~
