17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-207 is repealed.

20 ~~3-3-207. Sales to persons failing to provide for families.~~

21 ~~(a) Any person who shall sell intoxicating alcoholic liquor to any~~
22 ~~person who has been reported to the seller, by the juvenile court or any~~
23 ~~officer acting by its discretion, as failing to make a proper provision for~~
24 ~~his or her family shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not~~
25 ~~less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than two hundred fifty dollars~~
26 ~~(\$250) or imprisoned not less than ten (10) days nor more than sixty (60)~~
27 ~~days, or both so fined and imprisoned within the discretion of the court or~~
28 ~~jury. The penalties prescribed herein shall be in addition to any other~~
29 ~~penalty prescribed by law.~~

30 ~~(b) Any person found guilty a second time shall be fined not less than~~
31 ~~fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or confined~~

2 ~~give free lunches in any place where liquors are sold by such persons,~~
3 ~~company, or corporation.~~

4 ~~(b) Any person, company, or corporation violating the provisions of~~
5 ~~this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be~~
6 ~~punished by a fine of not less than twenty five dollars (\$25.00) nor more~~
7 ~~than one hundred dollars (\$100) or by imprisonment in the county jail for a~~
8 ~~period not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both the fine and imprisonment.~~
