## Subtitle

AN ACT TO REPEAL OBSOLETE LAWS
CONCERNING DEAD ANIMALS GENERALLY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 2, Chapter 40, Subchapter 3 is repealed.

Subchapter 3.- Dead Animals Genexally.

2-40-301. Penalty.
Any person, company, or corporation in any county of this state failing to do its duty provided in this subchapter or violating any of the provisions of this subchapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. Upon conviction, the offender shall be fined in any sum of not less than ten dollars ( $\$ 10.00$ ) nor more than fifty dollars ( $\$ 50.00$ ).

2-40-302. Cremation.
(a) When any horse, jenny, cow, sheep, goat, hog, dog, or other animal shall die from disease, accident, or other cause in the State of Arkansas, it shall be the duty of the person owning or having possession thereof of exercising control over it to immediately cremate the animal.
(b) This section shall not apply to any animal killed or slaughtered for food or commercial purposes.
2-40-303. Civil action.
(a) Any citizen of any county of this state in which the carcass of an
animal may be found is empowered to bring action in the name of the State of
Arkansas against the owner of the animal so neglected after death.
(b) No bond for cost shall be required of the citizen bringing the
action.
