Any unexpended balance of appropriation made by this Act, which 26 remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 2006, shall be 27 transferred forward and made available for any purpose other than Regular 28 Salaries and Maintenance and General Operations for the fiscal year ending 29 June 30, 2005 2007. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only 30 from July 1, 2003 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 31 32 SECTION 22. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS TRANSITIONAL EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM 33 OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Employment 34 Security Department, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas 35 Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas Employment Security Department, for personal

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. "REED ACT 9 10 FUNDS". Funds made available to the State under Section 903 of the Social 11 Security Act may be used, under the direction of the Employment Security Department with respect to federal fiscal years 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003 12 13 solely for the administration of the unemployment compensation program, for the purpose of construction, and improvement of buildings, rent/lease costs, 14 15 acquisition of land and/or for the payment of salaries, related benefits and 16 maintenance and operation of central and local office staff, or as otherwise 17 prescribed in Section 903 of the Social Security Act, as amended. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 29 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 32 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 36

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
