## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFER OF A PORTION  
11 OF INTEREST INCOME EARNED ON TREASURY INVESTMENTS  
12 TO THE ARKANSAS PROSTATE CANCER FOUNDATION, THE  
13 BREAST CANCER RESEARCH FUND, AND THE BREAST  
14 CANCER CONTROL FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE TRANSFER OF A  
17 PORTION OF INTEREST INCOME EARNED ON  
18 TREASURY INVESTMENTS TO THE ARKANSAS  
19 PROSTATE CANCER FOUNDATION, THE BREAST  
20 CANCER RESEARCH FUND, AND THE BREAST  
21 CANCER CONTROL FUND.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
26

27 SECTION 1. (a) From interest income received during the fiscal year  
28 ending June 30, 2006, by the Treasurer of State on the investment of state  
29 funds under the State Treasury Management Law, § 19-3-501 et seq., the  
30 Treasurer of State shall transfer one million five hundred thousand dollars  
31 (\$1,500,000) as provided in subsection (b) of this section.

32 (b) After complying with §§ 15-5-422, 15-41-110, 27-70-204, and 20-78-  
33 504, the Treasurer of State shall transfer from the remaining interest  
34 income:

35 (1) Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to the  
36 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the Arkansas Prostate Cancer



1 Foundation;

2 (2) One hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to the  
3 Breast Cancer Research Fund;

4 (3) Three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) to  
5 the Breast Cancer Control Fund; and

6 (4) Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to be credited to  
7 the University of Arkansas Medical Center Fund to be used in the Colorectal  
8 Cancer Research Program, if such a program is created by an act of the  
9 Eighty-fifth General Assembly.

10  
11 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
12 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that breast, colorectal, and  
13 prostate cancer affect more Arkansans each year; that many Arkansans die each  
14 year from those diseases; that early detection and cancer research will save  
15 or prolong lives; that increased funding for cancer detection and research is  
16 necessary in order to prevent needless suffering and death; and that this act  
17 is immediately necessary in order to provide needed funding as quickly as  
18 possible. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being  
19 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall  
20 become effective on July 1, 2005.
