1 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing 3 4 and other unusual expenses incurred by or in behalf of the athletic director, 5 assistant athletic directors, head coaches, and assistant coaches at the 6 University of Arkansas at Little Rock, the Board of Trustees may make special 7 allowances available therefor in such amounts as the Board of Trustees may 8 determine as justified, an equitable allowance in view of the unusual and 9 exacting duties of said athletic director, assistant athletic directors, head 10 coaches, and assistant coaches, and for the purpose of providing such 11 allowances, the Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary 12 income of the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, which is derived from athletic event receipts, an amount not to exceed twenty thousand dollars 13 14 (\$20,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during each year of the 2003-15 2005 2005-2007 biennium for the athletic director and head coaches, and ten 16 thousand dollars (\$10,000) in the aggregate for such purposes during the 17 2003-2005 2005-2007 biennium for the assistant athletic directors and assistant coaches. Provided that any such allowances shall be in addition to 18 19 the regular salary of such athletic director, assistant athletic directors, head coaches and assistant coaches, as established herein provided that the 20 21 amount of such allowance shall not exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) per 22 annum for any one salaried position. Further, if the special allowance funds 23 authorized herein are utilized the University of Arkansas at Little Rock 24 shall report annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact 25 disposition of those special allowances funds. 26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 27 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 28 29 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 31 32 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 33 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 34 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 35

will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during

- 1 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
- 2 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
- 3 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
- 4 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
- 5 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
- 6 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.
- 7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2003}{1}$

- 10 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- ll by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

- 13 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
- 14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

- 21 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

- 24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 28 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 30 <u>SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE.</u> It is found and determined by the General
- 31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
- 32 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
- 33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
- 34 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
- 35 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
- 36 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the

1	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
2	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
3	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
4	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
