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21 SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADULT EDUCATION DISTRIBUTION. All funds that become available for Adult Education 23 24 shall first be distributed to those administrative units determined to be 25 operating efficient and effective adult education programs, under criteria 26 established by the State Board of Workforce Education and Career 27 Opportunities. The criteria shall include the relative efficiency of 28 administration of the program in the counties served and achievement of 29 federal performance indicators. The State Board of Workforce Education and 30 Career Opportunities shall promulgate rules and regulation for the distribution of funds in accordance with criteria to be determined by the 31 32 Board. In the distribution of funds to local units the Board shall consider 33 the literacy rate in each county and performance in meeting state and federal 34 performance indicators. 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Unallocated funds will be redistributed based upon need as determined by the

An appropriation received by the various 9 technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers to support funds received from the Workforce 2000 Development Fund and which remains at 10 11 the end of any fiscal year shall carry forward into the next fiscal year. 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 13 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

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15 SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 17 OF FUNDS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish, upon request from the Department of Workforce Education, a special appropriation line item 18 19 to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. POSITION 9 FUNDING RESTRICTION. One position of Surplus Property Inventory Control Manager, two positions of Surplus Property Agent, and one position of 10 11 Secretary II authorized in this Act that are assigned to the Federal Surplus 12 Property Program are to be paid solely from fees generated by the program. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 14 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

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16 SECTION 32. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 17 FUND BALANCES. VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL RETIREMENT CASH FUND. (A) For all 18 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall 19 20 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly 21 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause the Vocational Technical 22 Retirement Cash Fund to decline below Eighty One Thousand Five Hundred Thirty 23 Dollars (\$81,530), the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the 24 executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under 25 these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation with 26 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the 27 expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to 28 justify the expenditures and shall include the following: 29 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such 30 expenditures on the fund balance. 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut 31 32 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 33 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 34 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 35 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not

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jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent

l depletion of the fund balance.

2 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
3 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
4 prior review by the Legislative Council.

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
6 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

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8 SECTION 33. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 34. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 18 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 35. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 29 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 32 33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 36
