FEDERAL 3 4 MATCHING. The funds appropriated in Sections 19, 20, 21 and 22 of this Act 5 may also be used to match any available federal funds from any agency in 6 order to provide the maximum amount of money possible for the purposes 7 enumerated in such section. 8 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 9 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 10 SECTION 24.
