21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 Arkansas Tech University for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
29 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
30 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
31 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
32 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
33 or its successor.

7 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FOOD
 9 SERVICE. If Arkansas Tech University cancels the current contract for food
 10 service and chooses to operate the food service with University employees,
 11 the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to
 12 utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided
 13 he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher Education and
 14 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the
 15 Arkansas Legislative Council.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
 17 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

18

19 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
 21 ALLOWANCES. The Board of Trustees of Arkansas Tech University may make
 22 special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in
 23 an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per year for any one coach during each year
 24 of the 2005-2007 biennium. Further, if the special allowance funds
 25 authorized herein are utilized, Arkansas Tech University shall report
 26 annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of
 27 those special allowance funds. The provisions of this section shall be in
 28 effect from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007.

30 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS
 32 TECH INSTITUTE. The Arkansas Tech Institute (ATI) shall be administered
 33 under the direction of Arkansas Tech University. Utilizing a
 34 multidisciplinary collaboration of professionals, ATI shall explore, develop,
 35 implement, and evaluate new and better ways to integrate the teaching, study
 36 and performance of business, engineering, and computer sciences for academic,

1 economic, and economic development purposes in Arkansas. ATI priorities
 2 shall include, but are not limited to, economic development, technology
 3 development, and “cyber-park” development. Arkansas Tech University shall
 4 make annual reports to the Arkansas Legislative Council on all matters of
 5 funding, existing programs, and services offered through ATI. The provisions
 6 of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2005 through June 30, 2007.

7
 8 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
 10 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged
 11 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the
 12 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief
 13 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December
 14 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or
 15 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during
 16 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due.
 17 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the
 18 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon
 19 release of the previous year’s audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal
 20 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board
 21 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
 23 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

24
 25 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 26 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 27 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 28 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures
 31 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 32 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 33 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 34 with in disbursement of said funds.

35
 36 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
7 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8
9 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
15 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
16 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
17 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
18 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
19 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.

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
