1 component a bungee cord, which is an elastic rope made of rubber, latex, or 2 other elastic-type materials whether natural or synthetic; 3 (B) "Go-kart", which means a ride in which a vehicle 4 controlled or driven by patrons specifically designed for and run on a fixed 5 course; 6 (C) Inflatable attractions such as "space walks", 7 inflatable slides, or inflatable jousting or boxing rings; and 8 (D) Any wave pool, water slide, or other similar 9 attraction that totally or partially immerses a patron in water; and 10 (E) Artificial climbing walls; 11 (3) "Department" means the Department of Labor; 12 (4) "Director" means the Director of the Department of Labor; (5) "Nondestructive testing" means the development and 13 14 application of technical methods, including, but not limited to, 15 radiographic, magnetic particle, ultrasonic, liquid penetrant, 16 electromagnetic, neutron radiographic, acoustic emission, visual, and leak 17 testing to examine materials or components in ways that do not impair their future usefulness and serviceability in order to: 18 19 (A) Detect, locate, measure, and evaluate discontinuities, 20 defects, and other imperfections; 21 (B) Assess integrity, properties, and composition; and 22 (C) Measure geometrical characters; and 23 (6) "Owner" means any person who owns an amusement ride or 24 attraction, or in the event that the amusement ride or attraction is leased, 25 the lessee. 26 27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 23-89-506(a)(4), concerning inspections and 28 fees for amusement rides, is amended to read as follows: 29 (4)(A) Inflatable attractions, and self-contained mobile 30 playgrounds, artificial climbing walls, and other patron propelled amusement rides or attractions shall be inspected every six (6) months, unless a more 31 32 frequent schedule of inspections is established by regulation of the director 33 for certain types of inflatable attractions and self-contained mobile 34 playgrounds. 35 (B) Self-contained mobile playgrounds, artificial climbing walls, and other patron propelled amusement rides or attractions shall be 36
